Finally, experience the vibrant art forms of Nirona Village before concluding your trip in Bhuj, a city rich in history and spirituality. ## **Key Highlights**

- Stay at the Tent City for 1N in Dhordo
- Stay in a traditional Bhunga in Dholavira and Dhordo
- Visit the Indus Valley site and fossil park at Dholavira
- Visit artisan villages in Kutch such as Nirona and Bhujodi where you get to see Rogan painting, Copper Bell making, Lacquered art work and weaving
- Visit the Rann Utsav at Dhordo.

## Rann Of Kutch Itinerary

- visit the white Rann at Dhordo. Overnight in Tent City
- Day 2: Tent City to Dholavira via Road to Heaven. En route, visit Kala Dungar also known as black hill. At Dholavira visit sunset point and fossil park. Overnight in Dholavira
- Day 3: Visit Indus Valley site at Dholavira. Travel back to Dhordo. Overnight in a traditional Bhunga style resort in Dhordo
- Day 4: Visit Nirona Village in the morning and meet the local artisan families who practice Rogan painting, lacquered art work and make copper bells. After that head to Bhuj and as per time available visit Swaminarayan Temple, Smritivan or Bhujodi. Drop at Bhuj railway station/bus stop in the night
